Game Information

- Practices will run 9:40am—10:10am. Scrimmages will immediately follow from 10:10am—10:40am.
- Each team will go to the assigned zone location (reference schedule for team assignments) and play a small field scrimmage 5v5 for approximately 20 minutes.
- Soccer Ball Size 3 will be used.
- Pop-up goals and cones will determine the field.
- There will be no goalie, no referee, and no score kept.

- Coaches will be on the field helping to direct the players and control the game.
- Players will be subbed often with all players playing at least half of the game.
- If the ball goes out of bounds the coach should retrieve the ball and roll it back into play.

What does my child need for practices/ games?

It's the responsibility of each parent/guardian to ensure their child(ren) arrive for each practice and/or game with; team t-shirt, cleats/ sneakers, shin guards, water bottle with name on it. Players may bring their own soccer ball at their own risk.
