Movie Night Procedures

Step 1: Confirm you are Pre-Registered

- ◆ Pre-Registration is required for admission to these events. Anyone who arrives and is not registered will be asked to leave the event grounds.

Step 2: Enter Rocky Hill High School Entrance on Parsonage St. Entrance

- ◆ In an effort to verify all our registrants and strategically park cars, we are requiring all vehicles enter Rocky Hill High School off of Parsonage Street. Entrances located off Chapin Ave. will be barricaded until the event has concluded.

Step 3: Follow Directional Signs Around Bus Loop to Check-In Station

- ◆ Directional signs will be placed on the event grounds for vehicles to follow.
- ◆ Please have a valid Photo ID ready when you reach the Check-In Station. This will be used to verify pre-registration.
- ◆ Once verified, you will be assigned a designated row (1, 2 or 3). At which time, you will proceed down into the lower parking lot and be directed into a parking space based on your vehicle size.

Step 4: Follow Instructions from Parks & Recreation Staff to Assigned Parking Location

- ◆ Our staff has already pre-assigned spaces designated for our attendees taking into consideration vantage points.
- ◆ Vehicles located on the ends may be asked to park diagonally by staff to ensure a great viewing of the screen.

Step 5: Once Parked...

- ◆ Vehicles must remain in the assigned space for the full duration of the movie. In the event you need to leave early please speak with one of our staff who will assist in escorting your vehicle off the grounds safely.
- ◆ Attendees must remain INSIDE their vehicle for the full duration of the movie unless you are exiting to purchase food and/or utilize a restroom.
- ◆ Prior to the movie starting, an FM station will be publicized on the screen informing you what frequency to utilize on your vehicle to listen to the movie.

Step 6: During the Movie...

- ◆ Feel free to visit any food vendors who may be on-site.

Step 7: Once the Movie has Concluded...

- ◆ Once the movie has concluded, staff will assist in directing vehicles safely off the grounds.

Reminders and Movie Etiquette

- **Assigned Spaces:** parking spaces have been pre-assigned based on vehicle size. Once directed into your parking space by our staff, it is expected your vehicle remains in that space for the duration of the movie.
- **Vehicle Lighting:** to ensure a quality experience for all, please ensure ALL vehicle lighting that has the ability to be turned off is done so.
- **Empty Spaces:** you will notice there are empty spaces tonight on the movie grounds. These have been purposely left empty to keep space between our vehicles to make the experience more enjoyable.
- **Radio Frequency:** Tonight's movie will be aired on 89.1FM unless otherwise noted.
- **Movie Conclusion:** the movie concludes, the lighting on the school grounds will be turned on, and staff will assist with departures.
