Important Weather Notice for Next Week's Campers

We're so excited to welcome your campers to Summerscape next week! As we finalize preparations, we want to give you a friendly heads-up about the current weather forecast.

Current predictions are showing extreme heat temperatures and a potential heat wave for parts of Connecticut next week.

As always, safety is our top priority at Summerscape. In light of this forecast, please expect adjusted schedules on days with inclement weather. We'll be making modifications to the camp schedule to ensure everyone stays safe and comfortable.

These changes may include, but are not limited to:

- Shortened durations of outdoor activities.
- Relocation of all scheduled outdoor activities to indoor spaces.
- Extra hydration breaks throughout the day.
 - Note: Please ensure your camper has their own water bottle at all times to help them stay hydrated. We have water bottle refill stations.
- Shared activities with neighboring grades to expand the usage of our indoor facilities (for example, Grades 4 & 5 might participate in a joint activity).

Additionally, on days of extreme heat, to reduce strain on the AC system of the campus, the sign-in/ out door may be closed entirely at the start of camp at 9:00am and you may need to contact camp the respective camp using the listed phone numbers above for entry.
