

The show takes place during our regular camp operations on Thursday, August 7th. We're excited to invite up to two parent/guardians per camper to attend and cheer on our stars! For safety, attendees must be previously listed as an authorized pick-up on your camper's emergency contact form. This is an exclusive event. Friends/ Family outside of the normal pick-up unfortunately are not permitted entry.

#### **Important Parent/Guardian Attendance Procedures**

To ensure a safe and organized event, please follow these procedures:

- 1. Arrival: Arrive at the gymnasium with your photo ID ready, just as you would for camper pickup.
- 2. **Verification:** Camp staff will verify you are an authorized pick-up using your photo ID. This will be strictly enforced.
- 3. Auditorium Access: Once verified, staff will direct you to the high school auditorium. Do not roam the building or visit other camp areas.
- 4. **Seating:** Campers and parent/guardians will be seated separately for the entire performance. Please remain in your designated section.
- 5. **Conclusion:** After the show, parent/guardians will be escorted back to the gymnasium. You may then proceed with the normal camper sign-out process if you wish. A special photo opportunity will be available after sign-out!
